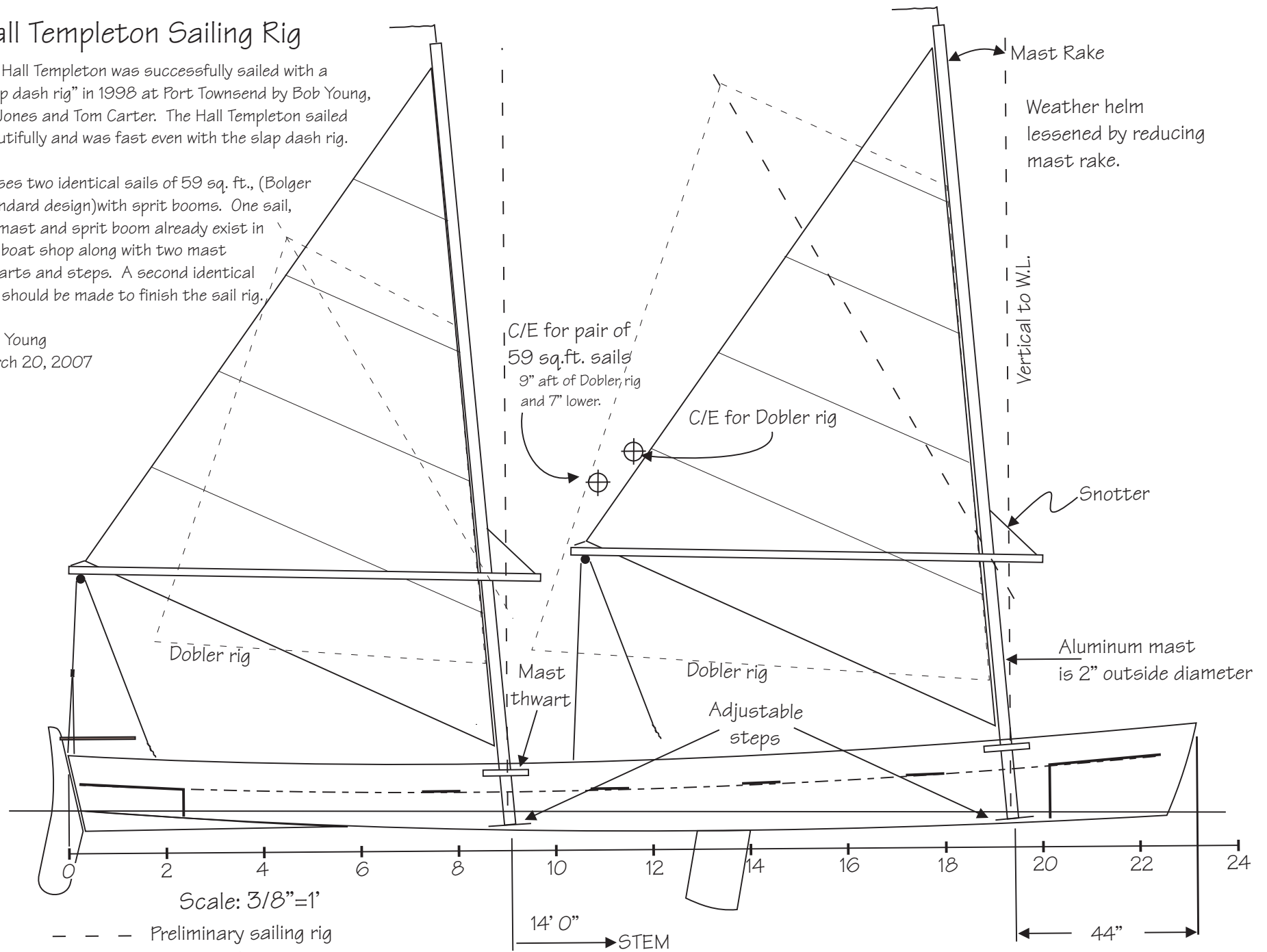


Hall Templeton Sailing Rig

The Hall Templeton was successfully sailed with a "slap dash rig" in 1998 at Port Townsend by Bob Young, Irv Jones and Tom Carter. The Hall Templeton sailed beautifully and was fast even with the slap dash rig.

It uses two identical sails of 59 sq. ft., (Bolger standard design) with sprit booms. One sail, its mast and sprit boom already exist in the boat shop along with two mast thwarts and steps. A second identical sail should be made to finish the sail rig.
