

Tools for plane making, Saturday 18, 2013

1. A square of some sort (tri-square, combination square,etc.)
2. Measuring tool; tape or 12" ruler.
3. #2 pencil or such.
4. Triangular saw sharpening file.
5. Sand paper, usual variety.
6. Rasp or coarse file.
7. Gouge; small narrow spoon or v or u (to inlet groove for thumbscrew blade retainer).
8. Other useful tools:
 - a. Block plane.
 - b. Protractor.
 - c. Compass
 - d. "Dremel" tool with assorted bits and wheels (to inlet thumb screw blade retainer.
 - e. Your favorite sharpening stones (to sharpen and hone the blade).
 - f. Safety glasses.
 - g. Your favorite small hand woodworking tools.

What is provided:

1. Allen wrenches for blades.
2. Blade attachment hardware.
3. Beechwood body blank.
4. Basic "Watco" oil and wax for finishing.
5. Templates to use in class.
6. Use of drill presses and bits.
7. Use of band saws.
8. Use of grinder and sander to form blades.
9. Use of some basic sharpening stones.
